

D-Mar's Bonanza Pups For Hunting/Field Trials

Classy puppies available by D-Mar's Bonanza ex Gunner's Nicky. These pups should be some of the best red hunting and shooting dog prospects available in 1994. I would keep them all if I could. I'd like to see these pups go to serious hunters and/or field trialers.



GUNNER'S NICKY

Nicky, a 2 1/2-year-old fireball, is my personal gun dog. She is a medium-range hunter that, despite her youth, has successfully hunted quail, pheasant and woodcock. She has style and class that far surpasses the average bird dog. She is more of a pleasure to shoot over than any dog I've ever owned or hunted with. Nicky is small, all red, has incredible foot speed and loves finding birds. To see her is to love her.

Nicky was sired by Colo's Gunner, an AKC open and amateur field champion who has twice finished third at the Irish setter AKC nationals. Gunner is a superb shooting dog with an excellent nose, and style and class to burn. He has 35 American Field placements and numerous AKC wins. Nicky's dam is Zansett Nickelodeon, an everyday hunter on a south Texas shooting preserve. Nicky's pedigree includes such greats as 3x Ch. Abra and 3x Ch. Abragail.



D-MAR'S BONANZA

Bo is a first-class red setter shooting dog. I believe he is one of the best in the nation -- the kind of red dog most people would love to have in their kennel. He can win a horseback shooting dog stake on the Kansas prairies one day, then hunt to the gun for a foot hunter the next. He's also the best bird finder I've ever witnessed in action.

Bo was the 1992-93 Runner-Up Kansas Open Shooting Dog of the Year — quite an accomplishment in a prairie state with many great pointers and English setters. He finished third for both the LeGrande and Duke trophies in 1993. I believe it's only a matter of time before he wins a major all-breed championship.

Bo was sired by Rawhide, another excellent prairie bird dog who was the 1985 Kansas All-Age Dog of the Year. His pedigree includes 3x Ch. Abra and Ch. Clancy O'Ryan.
