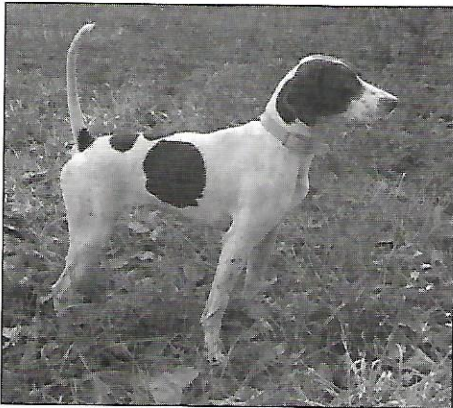


York Pointer and Setter Club
