The Championship will be made up of three courses so the handlers will be responsible for their own horses. This is prairie country for big running dogs on wild quail. Our judges will be Bill Bullock of LaPlatte, Mo., and J.D. Spears of Leawood, Kansas. Both know dogs.

At present the plans are to hold the drawing in LeRoy at one of the Veterans halls. More will be coming to you as well as maps to aid you in your travel. Hope you can be there!

I hope you have taken notice of the completed nominations in the Fourth Annual National Shooting Dog Futurity also in October. It will be at the Three Rivers Game Management area once again near Baldwins-ville, N. y. It will be preceded by the 1967 National Pheasant Shooting Dog Futurity rather Championship which is sponsored by the New York State Bird Dog Association. It is likely to start on Oct. 2 but size of the entry will determine this. Two IRISH SETTERS, 82 pointers, 40 English setters, two Vizslas and one Pudelpointer are listed. It is required that the litter be enrolled in the FDSB and all puppies in litters listed are eligible for entry. All of these litters are whelped on or after Jan. 1966.

Ed Schnettler of Clear Lake, Minn. is the banner bearer with dams, Schnet's Jenny K with Mr. O'Leary as sire and Schnet's Kate with Schnet's Little Red as sire.

"As Robert Wehle of Scottsville, N. Y., said, 'There is a special need for a breeders' event to encourage the development of class shooting dogs.' "
