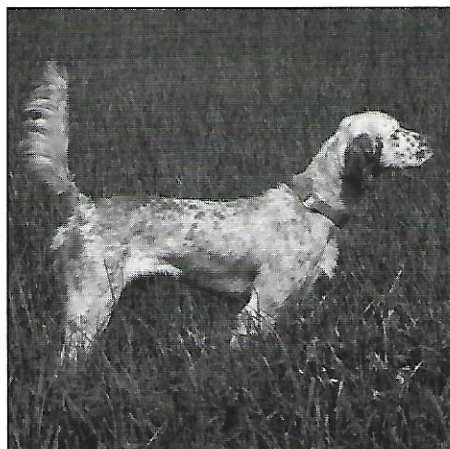
bested the field with three finds, two backs and a forward race. Jake, handled by Dave McKay, took second with four finds and a pleasing race.

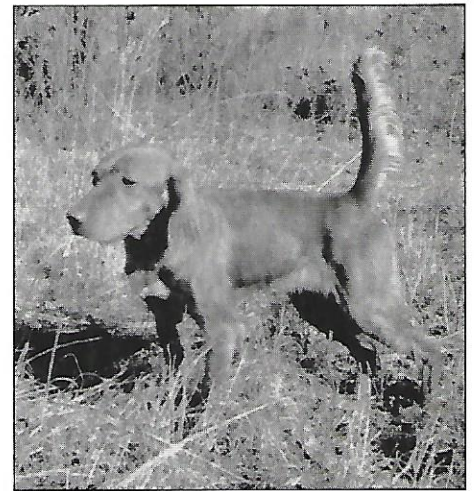
who attended and competed. Hope to see all of you again in September.
