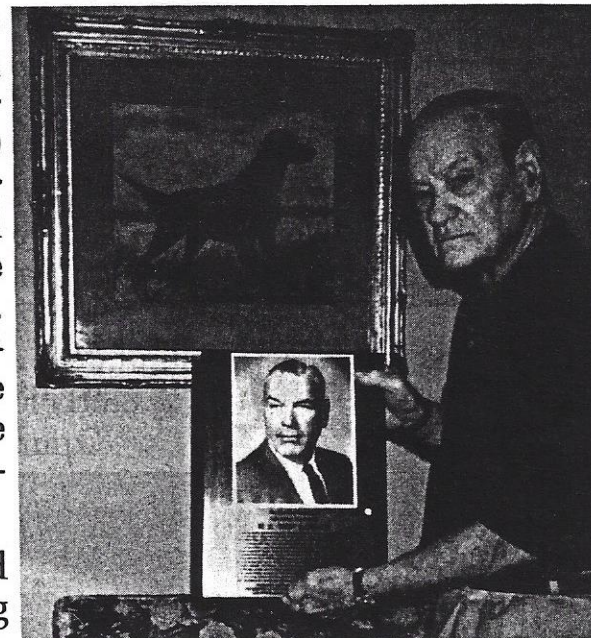


Vote for W.E. (NED) LeGRANDE
